Disabled Access

- All areas of a visit are fully-accessible for the disabled.
- If you require specific facilities, please contact us on 020 7882 2564.

Supervision / Behaviour

- All groups will be accompanied by two Centre of the Cell staff, who are fully briefed in all the Emergency procedures. NB: A scientist will also be present who will know the evacuation procedures but who is *not* responsible for first aid or Health & Safety during the visit.
- Visitors under 16 should be accompanied by one responsible adult for every fifteen children.
- Accompanying adults are responsible at all times for the behaviour of the minors they accompany.
- Those who disrupt the visit for others or whose behaviour puts themselves or others at risk will be asked to leave.
- Visitors may be asked to leave at any time at the discretion of Centre of the Cell staff.

First Aid

- Trained first-aiders will be on-call during all visits.
- Centre of the Cell is less than five minutes' walk from the Accident & Emergency Department at The Royal London Hospital.
- All Health & Safety incidents are reported and recorded.

Fire and evacuation

- Centre of the Cell staff are trained in our evacuation procedures; should it be necessary to evacuate please follow their instructions promptly and calmly.
- The assembly point is the large boulders on Turner Street, outside the Blizzard Building. Should this point be deemed unsafe, please follow instructions from Centre of the Cell staff.

Child Protection Policy

- All Centre of the Cell staff are CRB checked.
- Centre of the Cell's child protection policy is regularly reviewed and is available on request.
