

Assistant Explainer

Applications are invited for the post of Assistant Explainer at Centre of the Cell in the Blizard Institute. The post holder will be the first point of contact for visitors to Centre of the Cell and will help to deliver high-quality shows and workshops.

Candidates must be able to use their judgement and initiative and be effective and confident communicating with a diverse range of audiences.

The post operates on an ad-hoc timesheet basis to fit with Centre of the Cell's workload and staff availability. The post will start from January 2026, initially until July 2026 but with a strong likelihood of renewal to July 2027. The hourly rate is £14.98.

Final year students will not be considered. We will prioritise applications from students in their first or second year of study as well as those in their BSc intercalated year. This is because of the initial time commitment to gain the experience to deliver our shows and workshops with confidence. Promotion from Assistant Explainer to Explainer is possible after meeting certain criteria, such as proven reliability.

Candidates must be able to demonstrate their eligibility to work in the UK in accordance with the Immigration, Asylum and Nationality Act 2006. When required, this may include entry clearance or continued leave to remain under the Points Based Immigration Scheme.
